Dear Parents,

As part of our continuing eSafety programme, I have led two assemblies today on eSafety (one for FS & KS1 and one for KS2 pupils). As part of these assemblies, we have revisited key eSafety rules about staying safe online and using the internet and other communication technologies appropriately. We have also revisited cyberbullying.

In light of the forthcoming six week holiday and many children potentially making greater use of the internet and associated technologies over the summer break, I am also sending home eBehaviour agreements for next academic year.
