

Easter Events at Hoyland Springwood

In the run up to the Easter holidays, there will be a number of Easter events and activities taking place in school:



Decorate an Egg Competition

Children are invited to decorate an egg and enter the 'Decorate an Egg for Easter' competition. All eggs should be hard boiled before they are decorated. The completed eggs should be brought into school on either Tuesday 15th or Wednesday 16th March.

As we know it can be difficult for some children to be able to decorate their eggs at home, Mrs Parker and Mrs Clark will be running an egg decorating workshop on Monday 14th March at lunchtime. If your child would like to take part, please complete and return the slip at the end of this letter so that we know how many eggs to boil!

Judging will take place first thing on Thursday 17th – there will be one winner per class. Presentations will take place in assembly on Friday 18th. Eggs should be taken home on Friday 18th – any eggs left after school on this date will be disposed of as they will start to smell over the Easter holidays.

Easter Bonnet/Hat Competition

We will also be holding an Easter Bonnet/Hat competition. This will also be judged on Thursday 17th March. All children are able to enter. Children may either design and make their bonnet (or hat) at home or, alternatively, they can join Mrs Fletcher at a workshop session to make one (please see information below).

Easter Craft Session

Mrs Fletcher will be running an Easter craft session on Wednesday 16th March, after school (3.30-4.30pm). There is no charge for this session and it is open to all pupils. We would ask that FS and KS1 pupils are accompanied by an adult. There will be the opportunity to take part in a wide range of crafts, including making an Easter bonnet or hat. If you would like your child to take part in this workshop, please complete and return the slip below. Please also indicate if he/she would like to make a bonnet or hat so that we make sure we have enough.

Easter Coffee Morning

Our Easter Coffee Morning will be held on Thursday 17th March from 9am until 10.15am. Tea, coffee and hot cross buns will be served. You will be able to see the entries for the Easter Egg Decorating Competition and the children's Easter Bonnets/Hats. Our School Choir will also be performing.

Easter Disco

The Friends of Springwood are organising our annual Easter Disco. This will take place on Thursday 17th March from 6-7.30pm. This is open to all pupils at Hoyland Springwood and children from the Curious Cats. Primary age siblings who go to other schools are also welcome to attend but we would ask that parents do not send pre-school or older siblings. The children are invited to come in Easter-themed fancy dress for the fancy dress competition. We would ask that parents accompany Reception-aged children and any siblings from other schools. Tickets cost £1 and can be requested using the reply slip attached. Please send the slip and money in an envelope. Hotdogs, drinks and buns will be available to buy at the event. Please could we ask for donations of buns for the bun stall – please send these with your child on either Wednesday 16th or Thursday 17th March. Thank you.
