

# Easter Events at Hoyland Springwood

## April 2017

In the run up to the Easter holidays, there will be a number of Easter events and activities taking place in school:



### **Decorate an Egg Competition**

Children are invited to decorate an egg and enter the 'Decorate an Egg for Easter' competition. All eggs should be hard boiled before they are decorated. The completed eggs should be brought into school on either Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> April.

Judging will take place first thing on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> – there will be two winners per class. Presentations will take place in assembly on Friday 7<sup>th</sup>. Eggs should be taken home on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> – any eggs left after school on this date will be disposed of as they will start to smell over the Easter holidays.

### **Easter Bonnet/Hat Decorating**

We know that many children like to decorate an Easter Bonnet or hat. In previous years, these have been judged and a prize presented to the winning entry at the Easter Disco. The Friends of Springwood group have decided that this year, rather than a competition, there will be a small prize for all children who take part. If your child would like to take part in this, they should bring their completed bonnet or hat to school on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> April. The bonnets and hats will be displayed in the school entrance and should be taken home on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April.

## **Easter Coffee Morning**

Our Easter Coffee Morning will be held on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April from 9am until 10am. Tea, coffee and hot cross buns will be served. You will be able to see the entries for the Easter Egg Decorating Competition and the children's Easter Bonnets/Hats. Our School Choir will also be performing.

## **Easter Disco**

The Friends of Springwood are organising our annual Easter Disco. This will take place on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> April from 6-7.30pm. This is open to all pupils at Hoyland Springwood and children from the Curious Cats. Primary age siblings who go to other schools are also welcome to attend but we would ask that parents do not send pre-school or older siblings. We would ask that parents accompany Reception-aged children and any siblings from other schools.

Attendance at the disco costs £1 and places can be booked at the school office in advance or money can be paid on the door on the night. Hotdogs (50p), drinks (20p) and buns (20-50p) will be available to buy at the event. Please could we ask for donations of buns for the bun stall – please send these with your child on either Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> or Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> April. Thank you.
