Class Organisation 2018-19

I am pleased to be able to let you know about staffing and class organisation for next academic year. As always, we give considerable thought to both teacher and pupil placement. As a small school, there are always some mixed classes and, where this is the case, we endeavour to ensure that children are allocated to the class which best suits their needs, within the confines of pupils numbers etc.

The classes will be as follows:

Year Group(s)	Teacher	Further Information
FS2/Y1	Mrs Needham	All Reception children and most Year 1 children will be in this class.
Y1/2	Mrs Hoyle	All Year 2 children will be in this class with a small number of Year 1 children.
Y3/4	Mrs Fear	All Year 3 children will be in this class with some Year 4 children.
Y4/5	Mr Petitt	All Year 5 children will be in this class with some Year 4 children.
Y6	Mrs Parker	All Year 6 children will be in this class.

The children will be spending three days (Tuesday—Thursday) next week in their new classes to give them the opportunity to get to know their new teachers. Transition Days

Next week, our Year 6 children who are transitioning to Kirk Balk School will be visiting their new school on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. These days will also be our whole school transition days. Pupils currently in Reception to Year 5 will spend the three days with their new class teacher.

Children should come into their current classes on Tuesday morning and will then be dismissed from their new classes. On Wednesday and Thursday they should both enter and be collected from their new classes. There will be signs on classroom doors so you know where to collect from. We will arrange for the children's coats, bags, water bottles etc. to be moved across on Tuesday morning.

During the three days, the children will be taking part in a range of activities to get to know their new teachers and support staff as well as the other pupils. They will also be deciding on names for their new classes. Information about these will be sent home next week.
